SECTION 4: First aid measures**4.1 Description of first aid measures****General information**

In case of persisting adverse effects, consult a physician. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes immediately, and launder thoroughly before reusing. If the patient is likely to become unconscious, place and transport in stable sideways position.

After inhalation

Ensure supply of fresh air. Remove affected person from the immediate area. Irregular breathing/no breathing: artificial respiration. In case of breathing difficulties give oxygen.

After skin contact

When in contact with the skin, clean with soap and water.

After eye contact

Remove contact lenses. Rinse eye thoroughly under running water keeping eyelids wide open and protecting the unaffected eye (at least 10 to 15 minutes).

After ingestion

Rinse the mouth thoroughly with water. Do not induce vomiting - aspiration hazard. Call a doctor immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. In case of vomiting keep head of person in face-down position to prevent penetration of vomitus into the trachea.

4.2 Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed**Effects**

In the case of swallowing with subsequent vomiting, aspiration of the lungs can occur which can lead to chemical pneumonia or asphyxiation.

4.3 Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed

Poisonous symptoms can first be observed after several hours, therefore medical observation for at least 48 hours is necessary.
