SECTION 4: First aid measures**4.1 Description of first aid measures****General information**

Rinse the mouth thoroughly with water. Do not induce vomiting - aspiration hazard. Call a doctor immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. In case of vomiting keep head of person in face-down position to prevent penetration of vomitus into the trachea.

In the case of swallowing with subsequent vomiting, aspiration of the lungs can occur which can lead to chemical pneumonia or asphyxiation.
